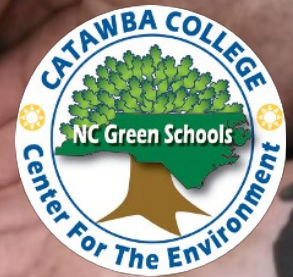




“School Yard Ecosystem Investigations”
